

## **WPS Role in Covenant Violations**

WPS Officers will verify covenant violations *after a complaint has been received and processed by the WIA staff* for the following:

- Trailers, RV's, Boats
- Commercial vehicles
- Off drive parking
- Excess vehicles parked in driveway or owners parking on the street

**WPS will not initiate any of these types of violations while conducting a vacation check or while on patrol.**

WPS Officers can and should *initiate* covenant violations for violations that are concerns for public safety such as:

- Open pit fires (campfires)
- Fireworks
- Discharging firearms in Woodmoor Common areas
- Loose and Aggressive dogs

**WPS Officers can and should *initiate* covenant violations for violations that are concerns for public safety when conducting a vacation check.**

WPS Officers will respond after a complaint has been received and attempt to verify violations of public peace or nuisance violations such as:

- Barking dogs
- Loose dogs
- Loud parties
- After hours construction noise (7am to 7pm) on ACC approved projects

**WPS Officers while on patrol should watch for construction projects underway and verify with the ACC Project Coordinator that the owners have approval for the project.**
