

# TREE CUTTING -- WIA Rules & Policies

## Woodmoor Improvement Association

- **WHY:**

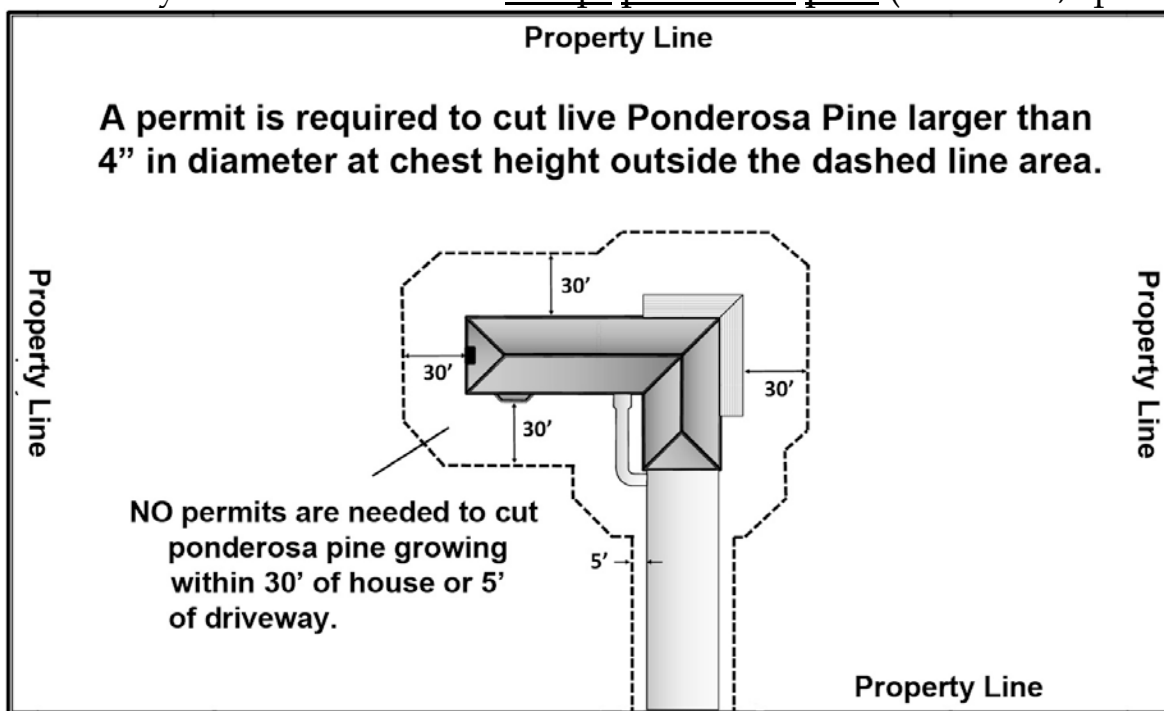
- To preserve the natural beauty & health of the native ponderosa pine forest.
- To prevent clear-cutting - CLEAR CUTTING IS NOT ALLOWED.
- To maintain property values.

- **WHEN DO I NEED A PERMIT:**

- To cut only larger ponderosa pines (greater than 4" dia. at chest height) -
  - Beyond 30 feet from house and deck (outside wildfire defensible space).
  - Beyond 5 feet of driveway.

- **WHEN DO I NOT NEED A PERMIT:**

- To cut any dead trees or shrubs.
- To cut any ponderosa pine less than 4" diameter at chest height.
- To cut any tree or shrub within 30 feet of house or 5 feet of driveway.
- To cut any other tree or shrub except ponderosa pine (scrub oak, spruce, etc).



**Permits are free and may be obtained by calling WIA office at 488-2693.**

- **TO REDUCE WILDFIRE and INSECT (MPB) RISK, REMEMBER:**

- Remove slash piles ASAP.
- Remove dead trees within 30 days.
- Wildfire fuel reduction takes priority over MPB concerns.
  - Remove all fresh cut pine from the property ASAP during the July 1 to October 1 MPB flight season.
