



2020 Woodmoor Improvement Association Scholarship for community service

The Annual Woodmoor Improvement Association Sponsored Scholarships will be awarded to the high school senior(s) and/or current college student(s) who best meet the requirements set forth by the Woodmoor Improvement Association (WIA) Board. Scholarship awards are limited to cover tuition, fees, and text books.

Award amounts are fixed at \$1000 and awards are at the discretion of the WIA Board.

The Selection Committee will review and score all submitted applications. Applicant's references may be contacted by telephone. The Scholarship Committee may choose to interview applicants. The scholarship recipients will be notified by July 15, 2020.

Guidelines for the WIA Sponsored Scholarship Program

Scholarships are open to graduating high school seniors and students currently enrolled at any college or university. There is no age limit for the scholarship. Scholarship monies will be paid directly to the educational institution in the student's name, or by exception, to the student with Board approval.

Criteria: Student applicants must be active residents in the Woodmoor community, as defined by the covenants handbook and the household must be in good standing with WIA dues.

Student applicants must meet the following guidelines:

1. Plan to attend, or currently attend an accredited college or university on a full-time basis.
2. Must have a Grade Point Average (GPA) of 2.75 on a 4.0 scale.
3. Must complete 20 hours of community service, with extra consideration given to community service in the Woodmoor area. Contact WIA at (719) 488-2693 for ideas.
4. Must have acquired acceptance to, or be enrolled at the college of his/her choice and must be an enrolled full-time student for the fall semester of 2020.

Student applicant should note any special financial needs on their application form.

All applications and supporting documents must be received no later than May 30, 2020.
